## Booking process

- 1 Fill out the Ready to Book form found at [IndyArts.org/the-artsgarden](http://IndyArts.org/the-artsgarden). An Indianapolis Artsgarden representative will review your request and contact you.
- 2 Schedule a walkthrough and meeting with the Indianapolis Artsgarden staff.
- 3 If you choose to move forward with booking, you will receive a contract to sign. Return the signed contract with deposit to officially reserve your event's date.
- 4 At least 90 days before the event, submit a certificate of insurance. You can obtain this through your residential insurance agent or an online provider.
- 5 If desired, set up a time to meet with Indianapolis Artsgarden staff about two weeks before event.
- 6 The remainder of your balance must be received no later than seven days before your event.
